- ✓ *A deposit of \$500 will be required by April 30th. This deposit can be made in cash or check, or payment made via direct deposit through the accounts office.*

The total cost and itinerary will be provided when the numbers of students attending is finalized April 30th. The cost will be between \$2500-\$2900. There will be an information session for parents and students **May 3rd at 5:00 pm in Science Lab**. You will have the option to pay in installments.

The proposed installment schedule is as follows:

April 30 th	\$ 500
June 25 th	\$ 500
September 7 th	\$ 1000
October 6 th	the remainder (I will inform you of this amount at the May information session)
