Eileen Dunstan Open-Heart Award

Eileen Dunstan attended MSA from the 1940's until leaving in Grade 11 following the death of her father. The importance of education was never lost on her and at the age of 40, while holding down a full-time job and being a full-time mom to 3 kids, Eileen went to Bermuda College to studying book-keeping. Despite never having graduated high school herself, Eileen made sure all of her kids got a first-rate education at MSA and quietly provided tuition assistance to her 'special God-children'. An active parishioner at St. Theresa's she taught CCD for many years and busily assisted with coffee socials, bible study groups, and the monthly Loaves & Fishes program. This award is in her honor and in her memory.

The Eileen Dunstan Open-Heart Award program is designed to provide financial incentive to qualified high school students who exemplify those qualities of selfless giving, community involvement and a dedication to academic achievement.

A \$20,000 tuition grant will be awarded to the successful applicant at the end of Grade 9 and delivered in instalments of \$5,000 in Grade 10, \$5,000 in Grade 11 and \$10,000 in Grade 12. This program will be awarded to one (1) student annually and run for the academic years 2016/2017 through 2020/2021

Scope of Scholarship

This scholarship program has been established to provide a direct grant toward tuition costs. Funds will be applied directly against the successful recipient's tuition.

Criteria for Selection

- Candidate must hold Bermuda Status
- Candidate must be in Grade 9 at time of application
- Candidate must have an average of B (70%) or better
- Candidate must be involved with the school (i.e. student government, sports, music, stage crew, etc) and participate in volunteer/community activities outside of the school
- Candidate must maintain the above criteria for the duration of the Award

Required Documentation

- Completed application form
- Personal letter describing why you applied for this award

Terms & Conditions

- The Award will be in effect for Grades, 10, 11 and 12
- A cumulative average of B (70%) or better must be maintained by the recipient.
- The Award Committee reserve the right to terminate the award if, in the Committee's discretion, the recipient's academic performance or conduct proves to be unsatisfactory (e.g. academic probation, disciplinary action from school, etc.).
