



Grade 4 Supply List 2018-2019

Welcome to Grade 4! I am so excited to get to know you and your families next school year. Below is a list of tools you will need for Grade 4. It is extremely helpful to have ALL school supplies/tools clearly labeled. Enjoy your summer!

- 1 package of colored pencils OR crayons
- 1 package of markers
- 1 package of wide-ruled lined paper (please place binder paper in binders before the beginning of school)
- Page reinforcements or binder paper with page reinforcements
- Paperback dictionary AND thesauruses (some dictionaries have both. Please avoid purchasing the student version as the vocabulary is limited)
- 1 package of assorted color construction paper
- 2 glue sticks AND small bottle of Elmer's glue
- 1 ruler (inches & centimeters)
- 1 pack of basic #2 pencils (pre-sharpened and not retractable)
- 1 red OR colorful pen that is not retractable
- 2 blue or black ballpoint pens that are not retractable
- 1 enclosed pencil sharpener
- 1 pair of student pointed scissors
- 1 medium size zippered pencil case that fits inside the desk
- 2 highlighters
- Storage USB Flash Drive 4-6 GB
- 1 basic calculator

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- 2 binders (2") with 10 dividers that are **pre-labeled**.

One binder should be labeled with the following subjects: Mathematics, Language Arts, Social Studies, Computers, Miscellaneous and Religion.

The other binder should be labeled with the following: Spanish, Portuguese, French and Italian. One binder is for World Languages and the other binder is for the classroom.

- 2 black dry erase/EXPO markers to be used by the students
- 1 scotch tape
- 2 large zippered mesh pouch: One for Science and one to be used for homework.
- Yamaha recorder for Music – it may be purchased at Music Box
- Required Music folder for purchased in September at the cost of \$2



The following items are for the **classroom** use and are **NOT** mandatory:

- ★ 1 box of Kleenex
- ★ Disinfecting Wipes such as Clorox wipes

Please ensure that all clothing, school supplies including hats are clearly labeled.

All students must have a set of MSA P.E. clothes and a MSA hat to be worn during recess and lunch. Notebooks and school planners will be given out in September.

Please continue to **READ, READ, READ** over the summer and keep track of your reading for A.R. points! Review your multiplication facts from 3-5, 10 and practice facts from 6-9 as this will be a very helpful skill in Grade 4. Our rule of thumb is to know your facts in 3 seconds or less!
