Welcome to Grade 3! Below is a list of tools your child will need. It is extremely helpful to have **ALL** school supplies/tools **clearly labeled**. Some items will be provided which include pencils, erasers, pens, highlighters and scissors. Please purchase the following supplies:

- 1 package of colored pencils **OR** crayons
- 1 package of markers
- Paperback dictionary
- 1 package of assorted color construction paper
- 2 glue sticks **AND** small bottle of Elmer's liquid glue
- 1 medium size zippered pencil case that fits inside the desk (for crayons/markers)
- 2 black dry erase/EXPO markers to be used by the students
- 1 scotch tape
- 1 large zippered mesh pouch for Science
- 1 over-sized T-Shirt or apron for arts and crafts
- 1 package of white index cards

- ★ 1 package of baby wipes

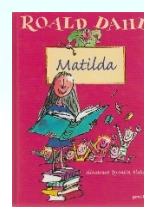
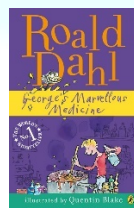
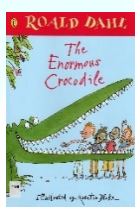
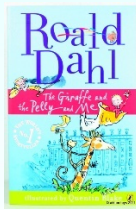
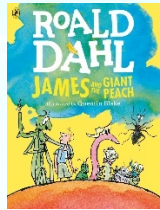
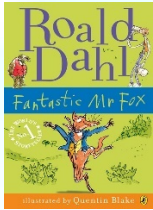

Please continue to **READ, READ, READ** over the summer and keep track of your reading for A.R. points!

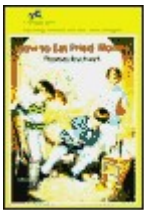

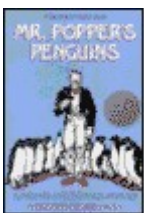


Novels by Roald Dahl such as BFG or Fantastic Mr. Fox to name a few

Billy makes a bet with his friends that he can eat 15 worms in 15 days. Why not read this book to find out if he succeeds?



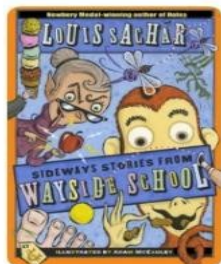
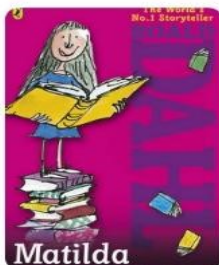
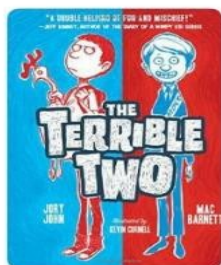
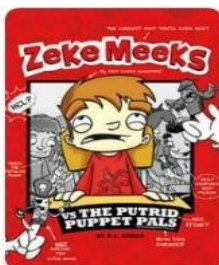
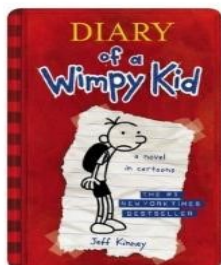
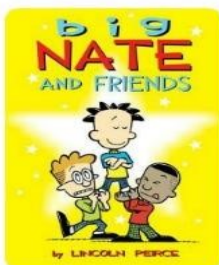
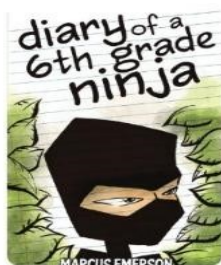
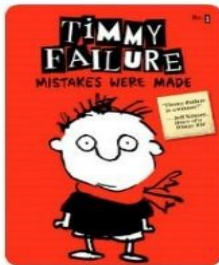
Mr. Popper's Penguins by Richard Atwater, Florence Atwater, Robert Lawson (illus.)
