



Middle School Supply List 2020-2021

General List

- 2 book covers for textbooks
- folders for each subject (12 to be safe)
- loose-leaf paper
- pens: blue, black and red
- at least one erasable pen
- colored pencils and markers
- one fine point black Sharpie marker
- one small pencil sharpener
- highlighters
- one 12-inch ruler (metric included)
- one roll of scotch tape
- one package of index cards (The color, line width and size of the cards does not matter.)
- one whiteboard marker
- one dictionary – It must have pronunciation key, parts of speech for every word and synonyms. It should be one which can carry over into high school.
- one thesaurus
- a supply of individual Kleenex on-the-go small packs – These should always be kept at home with each student carrying one pack with them.
- one pair of scissors
- one 4-inch protractor
- one zippered pencil case
- glue sticks and roll-on double-sided tape
- dry corrective tape
- one 2" binder (D-ringed if possible)
- one small pad of Post-It Notes (The Post-Its need to be able to fit inside of the student's pencil case.)
- one package of construction paper
- one USB data stick (4GB minimum)
- one pair of inexpensive headphones (The headphones should be non-Bluetooth.)

Subject or Grade Level-Specific List

- Math: one scientific calculator (This item will be used through to Grade 9. A Texas Instrument is recommended – models T1-34, T1-30X IIS or T1-36x Pro with Multiview display.)
- French: one 1" binder with 5 dividers
- Physical Education: one uniform – blue MSA shirt and shorts, white athletic socks, non-marking athletic sneakers, water bottle
- Grade 6: two 1" binders with (10 dividers)
- Grade 7: two 1" binders with (10 dividers)
- Grade 8: one 2½" - 3" binder or two 1" or 1 ½" binders

**Please ensure that all items are clearly labeled. Students will need these items for the whole school year, so lost / used items may need to be replaced.
